

CITY OF ANGLETON GUIDELINES CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT

REQUIREMENTS FOR RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES

- a. New homes shall have a survey and a set of building plans submitted for permitting. There must be a windstorm engineer assigned to the project.
- b. Builders must be TRCC registered to permit a job.
- c. If a dwelling is going to be added on to or a storage building or garage constructed, a permit along with a survey of the property showing existing structures and the location of the new structure to be built.
- d. All drawings must show in detail how the building is constructed and the drawing stamped by a windstorm engineer indicating that the structure meets the 120 mph wind resistant requirement for this area.
- e. Structures cannot be placed on dedicated easements or right-of-ways.
