### ACCT Cancellation & No-Policy:

Cancellations need to be given (2) hours in advance before scheduled pick up. Therefore, ACCT encourages you to cancel your ride at any time before (2) hours of your scheduled pickup. There will be no penalty as long as you cancel your trip (2) hours in advance of the scheduled pick up. If you do not cancel your trip before the (2) hours before your trip, then there is a penalty, which is called a no show.

A no show is when you do not cancel your trip (2) hours in advance or when you do not appear within (5) minutes after arrival of the scheduled transport provider. You will be billed for the no-show before another trip can be scheduled.

Please remember to allow for the (30) minute window (15 minutes before or 15 minutes after the scheduled pick up time). Within a 30 day period, (3) no shows may result in a loss of riding privileges up to a 14 day period.

Scheduling Hours for ACCT

Monday-Friday

7: 30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

Closed Saturdays, Sundays and all major holidays

Hours of Transportation:

Transportation Providers are Ashland Public Transit and Ashland County Council on Aging and the hours will be from Monday-Friday 6:00-9:00 p.m. Saturday 8:00 a.m.-9:00 p.m. and Sunday 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

ACCT is the transportation system for Ashland County and provides demand response, curb to curb public transportation service. Assistance is available upon request.

To Schedule a Transport:

Please call Ashland Community Coordination Transit at (419) 281-4730 to schedule your ride. ACCT suggests that you call two business days prior to your schedule ride., but will provide same day service if space is available. Please provide your name, phone number, appointment time, and length of appointment when you schedule your trip



FARE STRUCTURE



ALL ZONE TRIPS START AT ZONE 2, WHICH IS THE BASE:

Zone 1: \$1.00 plus base zone charge of \$5.00 for General Public or \$4.00 for Elderly/Disabled for a one-way trip

Zone 2: \$5.00 per person one-way trip for General Public or \$4.00 per person one-way trip for Elderly/Disabled

Zone 3: \$1.00 plus base zone charge of \$5.00 for General Public or \$4.00 for Elderly/Disabled for a one-way trip.

Maximum Cost: For all one-way trips for all three zones is \$7.00.


EXAMPLE: Start Zone 3 to Zone 1 end trip =\$7.00

Elderly & Disabled Discount (Yellow Card):



If you are disabled or are 65 years of age and older and can show proof such as an Ohio Buckeye card, driver's license or birth certificate then you may qualify for a discount fare. Please call ACCT at (419) 281-4730 for more information.
