- 4) <u>Broadcast System Upgrade</u> It was agreed to place the Price quote in the amount of \$22,918.27 for equipment purchase and installation on the February 8 Regular Council Meeting agenda for approval.

The following items were discussed:

- 1. BPPD Security Upgrade Door Fob. Council authorized moving ahead with the Door Fob purchase. This is the door located at the hallway outside the communications office.
- 2. Contractual Services to Move Door Access Control Equipment. Council authorized moving ahead with the Door Access Control Equipment.
- 3. Security Cameras Council authorized moving forward with the purchase and installation of 6 security cameras to be placed inside the police department, the stairwell, and the lobby areas of the Municipal Building.
- 4. Personalized benches at Municipal Parks Staff is recommending that Council decide on a style personalized benches. This is a bench that residents can purchase to as a remembrance opportunity. - 8. Logan Road Traffic Improvement Feasibility Study Council approved staff to obtain RFP's for a feasibility study at the intersection.
