MOURY: Thank you, Mr. O'Brien. 10 Planning and zoning, Ms. Gibbons, would 11 you kindly take that position? 12 MS. GIBBONS: Yes. 13 MR. MOURY: Thank you, Ms. Gibbons. 14 15 And public works and maintenance, Mr. Consolmagno? 16 Absolutely. MR. CONSOLMAGNO: 17 MR. MOURY: Thank you, Mr. 18 19 Consolmagno. Before we adjourn here because I know 20 it's a brief meeting, since we've got a crowd, 21 and you're not allowed to speak at the 22 microphone, just so you know --23 24 (Laughing was heard.) MR. a few minutes maybe to talk a little bit about kind of what we do and maybe while I sometimes chastise people for talking about the past on this floor, but I'd like to talk briefly about the past.

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This is my 24th year serving on Council, and it's -- a little collection. My parents used to do a scrapbook. But I think the one thing in common with everything we -- we have done is we've been able to accomplish this as a group. We may not always agree, and I guess we'll agree to disagree and move on, we don't always get what we want, but the success of the community has been -- or of this group has been our ability

to work together.
