In 2005 he was promoted to special agent in the Bureau of Criminal Investigations, and then while working for the Attorney General full time, he pursued his undergraduate degree from Robert Morris University.

In March 2014, upon a nomination by Governor Tom Corbett, the State Senate unanimously confirmed his appointment as District Judge for District Court 05-2-20, serving the Municipality of Bethel Park and the town -- the Township of Upper St. Clair.

In 2016, Judge Ronald Arnoni ran and was -- and was elected by the people of his district.

So we are honored and blessed to have you come over and officiate the ceremony, and we totally appreciate it.
