This is a Public Hearing for transfer of a liquor license. Just so everybody understands, the application has been made by EB Park, LLC to transfer a Liquor License No. R-6705 from the City of Pittsburgh to a location at 4607 Library Road, Bethel Park, PA, 15102.

The way the process will work this evening is we have our Director of Engineering will give an overview of what the Public Hearing is on the transfer of the license.

At that time, we will open the floor up to proponents, people that would be in favor of this transfer, or opponents, people that would be against.

And I know the Applicant is here.

You have an opportunity, if you'd like to say anything. If not, we have a meeting scheduled for 7:30 this evening. This application is on our agenda for Council to review.

So, at this time, I would like to turn to Stacey Graf, Director of Engineering, to give an overview of what we're here for

MS. GRAF: Provided before Council is an application for a transfer of a liquor license from the City of Pittsburgh to the Municipality of Bethel Park. The Applicant, EB Park, LLC, is requesting approval of a transfer of Pennsylvania Restaurant Liquor License No. R-6705 into the facilities located at 4607 Library Road, Millennium Shops. The property is owned by 88 Investigators, LP, and is located in the Fifth Ward.

The license is currently owned by M&J Asian Bistro, Inc. The current address of this license is 5700 Centre Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA, 15206.

The Municipality received a request for approval for the transfer in accordance with the rules and regulations as administered by the PA Liquor Control Board. The request was made via way of correspondence dated December 11, 2019, with the fees received to complete the application on December 23, 2019. The Municipality assigned the Application No. 2019-0898.

As per the requirements of the

Pennsylvania Liquor Code, the Municipality is required to hold a public hearing for the purpose of receiving comments and recommendations of interested parties, individuals residing within the Municipality concerning the application's intent to transfer the liquor license into the Municipality.

The public hearing was advertised in the December 27, 2019 and January 3, 2020 South Editions of the Pittsburgh Post Gazette. Notices regarding the public hearing were sent to known property owners located within 500 feet of 4607 Library Road. Also, the property was posted with notices regarding the public hearing.

The Municipality is required to act on the request within 40 days -- 45 days of receipt. Council shall be -- shall act by adopting a resolution indicating its decision. Council must take action on this application at its Regular Council Meeting at 7:30 p.m. on January 13, 2020.
