## **General Announcements**

- 5/11: BPPD was called to Sandy Creek Apartments for 2 suspicious males wearing hoodies, masks and backpacks, who ran from a vehicle when the car alarm activated. The suspects were caught by officers at a trolley stop up the road and found to be in possession of stolen property from residents of Lindenbrooke Apartments. The males were identified as Andrew Dwyer (18) and William Redfearn (19), both of Mt. Oliver. They were transported to the Allegheny County Jail and charged with Theft from a Motor Vehicle, Receiving Stolen Property, Criminal Conspiracy and Loitering and Prowling at Nighttime.
- 5/16: The BPPD worked with South Hills Interfaith Movement and the Greater Pgh Community Food Bank to distribute food at 957 vehicles at South Hills Village Mall.
- 5/19: The US Attorney's Office in Nevada has indicted John Matthew Chapman in the kidnapping and death of Bethel Park resident Jaime Feden. The initial charges filed by BPPD have ben with
- 5/21: BPPD recently arrested Casey Cunningham (39) and David Rutter Jr. (30) of the East Liverpool, OH area, after coming to the Bethel Park Home Depot to commit a high-dollar retail theft. Both also had warrants from other agencies and are currently being held in the Allegheny County Jail.
