Good evening, Council. Good to see everybody. Residents of Bethel Park. My name's Rob Uselman. I'm the Assistant Chief of the Bethel Park Volunteer Fire, Company. And I'm here for the Chief's Report for July 2022.

So we'll get straight into the incidents. We had a total of 49 calls in July. A rather busy month for us. We had five structure fires, three other type fires, (cooking, trash and brush) one vehicle fire, one vehicle extrication, five gas leaks, two CO incidents, seven electrical conditions due to some storms that came through, one vehicle accident, four with assisted police, one standby in a neighboring community, three good intent calls, one smoke investigation, and 15 fire alarms, for a total of 49 incidents. So it was a busy month for us.

Please stay safe out there as we head into August. Here we are. Now, one thing we always talk about in the fire service is, we make sure -- we want to make sure that the public is aware and has smoke alarms. And, really, you should have smoke alarms on every

1 home -- on every level in your home, inside
2 your bedrooms, and outside sleeping areas.

We know we always talk when the time changes to change your batteries. But you should test those smoke detectors once a month. And usually the instructions come with the manufacturing guidelines that you get on the smoke detectors when you purchase them.

Make sure you talk with your family members on what the smoke detectors sound like, what to do in case you hear the smoke detector go off, especially with your younger children, if you have children.

And, also, it's always good to
help -- I have teen-agers. They don't listen
like they used to, you know. But it's good to
remind them what to do in case the smoke
director goes off and who to call and what to
do in case there is a fire.

And if there is -- if a fire does occur in your home, please get out, stay out, and call for help.

And that's all I have for this evening.
