1. Call to Order

- a.) Chairman Hannan called the April 23, 2026 Meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

2. Roll Call

a.) Secretary Beaver called the roll.

- i. Present for roll call: Messer's. Jim Hannan, Tim Moury, William Ruhl, Dave Brodnos, Michael Janosik, Bruce Beaver and Dan Cheberenchick .

Also present: Mr. Joseph Gaydos, Jr., Bethel Park Solicitor, Gaydos Law, PC; Mr. Jake Miller, Superintendent. Bethel Park Wastewater Treatment Plant and Mr. Jonathan Gibson-Comer, Assistant Wastewater Plant Supervisor; Ms. Kaylee Murphey and Mr. Joshua Jedlicka of Wade Trlm; Ms. Kristen Denne, Bethel Park Municipal Manager and Mr. Joe Janosik, Bethel Park Council President.

3. Roll Call

- a.) Mr. Hannan called for a motion to approve the minutes of the March 2026 BPMA Regular Meeting. Mr. Moury motioned to approve. Mr. Ruhl seconded. Roll call was unanimous. Motion carried 7-0.**

4. Correspondence

- a.) There was no correspondence.

5. Facility Discussion and Superintendent Report

Mr. Miller reported on WWTP and LRPS. Mr. Gibson-Comer reported on Lab results.

a.) WWTP

- i. Mr. Miller reported that the new effluent water tank for the sludge press that failed was installed this week end is working correctly.
- ii. Wet Testing is this week. Mr. Miller explained that Wet Testing is when minnows are placed in the effluent water to determine how long they survive, grow and if they reproduce. The test is done on different concentrations of effluent. The test is done once per year, unless the test is a failure. If there is a failure, the Plant can retest. When a new NPDES Permit is issued, testing is done 4 times per year. After passing the NPDES 4 times per year testing, the Plant returns to once per year standards. Results will be available at a later date.
- iii. The storage unit for the doors has been picked up.
- iv. Confined Space Training was completed on 4-16-2026.
- v. Apparently, there is a beaver issue near the Plant. The beavers dropped a tree on a fence. There has been no further evidence of their presence recently.
- vi. For several days, there have been issues with the Secondary Sludge Pumps. The staff has unsuccessfully worked to repair the pumps. An electrician will be onsite to determine if there are electrical problems with the pumps. There is an additional pump at the Plant that is running.
- vii. The Waste Management team will be at the May 14, 2026 BPMA Workshop meeting to discuss the Agreement with the BPMA and Waste Management. 3 representatives of Waste Management will attend. Mr. Hannan advised Mr. Miller to email the current Agreement to the Board members for review.

b.) Lick Run Pump Station

i. Auma repaired a valve actuator with a bad electrical component which was under warranty.

c. Lab Reports

i. Mr. Jonathan Gibson-Comer reported 2 exceedances for the March 2026 DMR. He attributes the exceedances to high flows.

ii. The REC phosphorous has been under 2 except for the last 2 days.

6. Municipal Engineering Reports- South Park, Bethel Park

a.) Mr. Beaver reported on South Park's Projects

i.) South Park is waiting on the contractors to begin their projects.

b.) Car Wash In Bethel Park

i. Mr. Hannan asked Ms. Denne if the car Wash representatives had contacted her. Ms. Denne responded that she has not been contacted by them. Ms. Denne added that she needs to talk to Mr. Gaydos about doing an addendum to the Developer's Agreement, Ms. Denne sent the car wash representatives a Draft Agreement. The representatives were working on their financing in April 2026.

ii. Mr. Gaydos stated that he has tried to contact the car wash representatives several times this week and has not received a response. Mr. Gaydos will continue to follow up on the car wash.

c.) Mr. Miller presented Ms. Faunce's Report

i. Ms. Faunce is Preparation for 2026 O&M contracts:

*Preconstruction photos for all dig locations

*Mapping for lining /CCTV locations

*Coordinating of CCTV contractor with Wincan to streamline review process and storage of data in one location

*Collecting data for Phillippi location (dye test, previous work completed, rainfall)

*Will be ready for discussion at 5/14 workshop meeting

*Coordination with Wade Trim on Phase II Consent Order Agreement

*Commercial dye tests 4/16 & 4/17 for 7000 Oxford Dr (Giant Eagle) and 14 Fort Couch Rd (Get Go)

*Waiting for Folino Construction quote to complete manhole repairs needed for PennDOT paving project- 13 manholes

7. Wade Trim- Professional Engineering Service

Ms. Murphey reported on Wade Trim's Projects

a.) **Centrifuge and EQ Project-** The Project is progressing. Wade Trim received the EQ Pumps information requested from the manufacturer and is waiting for an actual cost quote. Ms. Murohey added that she needs to review the drawings and scope to determine if anything should be added or removed.

b.) **The REC Tank** – Ms. Murphey asked Mr. Gaydos if the BPMA could enter into a quorum to approve finalizing the drawings and advertisg for bids at the May 14, 2026 Workshop Meeting. The consensus was that all meetings are advertised and open to the public and therefore allowing for a vote on approval. Ms. Murphey added that with an approval vote bids will officially open on May 12, 2026 or May 13, 2026 depending on newspaper advertising. The Board discussed which newspaper to use for publication. Mr. Gaydos will review the BPMA By-Laws and the legal statues regarding newspaper Pin Bid will also be used for advertising publication of bids. Staff and Mr. Gaydos will review newspaper publication requirements.

c.) **Lower Library Lining Project (Kings School Road to Beagle Drive)-** The Project remains on hold for funding through the Representative Summer Lee CWSRF Grant.

d.) Catfish Run Interceptor Lining Grant- The Project remains on hold for funding through the LSA Grant.

e.) Rt. # 88 Sanitary Sewer Improvements (MH 3B13-3B11)- The survey is scheduled for May 18, 2026. The overall schedule sent to the Board members is still good for the project. When Wade Trim receives the survey, they will do the site layout. The work needs to be completed regardless of any changes in plans for the site.

f.) Connor Road Sewer Improvements (MH2A29-MH2A28A) - The work is scheduled approximately 2 weeks before Rt. # 88 work. The survey is scheduled for April 28, 2026. They will move ahead with the site layout after receiving the survey.

g.) The Chapter 94 Report for the WWTP was submitted March 31, 2026.

h.) The document for the old Headworks Project stating that the Permit can stop being enforced is signed and will be submitted.

i.) There is no additional information on the Collection System to report and there are no additional Planning Modules.

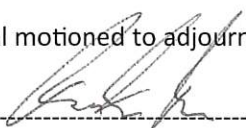
Mr. Ruhl motioned to approve. Mr. Moury seconded. Roll call was unanimous. Motion carried 7-0.
