Parking Lot Near Fairgrounds, Concert Area in South Park to Close Tomorrow

PITTSBURGH – The Department of Public Works announced today that crews have begun mobilizing and will soon start demolishing a deteriorated parking lot above the old fairgrounds site near the intersection of Brownsville Road and Corrigan Drive in South Park. The parking lot, which is being replaced, will close on Tuesday, June 22 and will not be available to the public until late 2021. That may impact available parking for those attending the Summer Concert Series, so concert goers should plan accordingly.

A ceremonial groundbreaking is expected to occur in early July before work begins to transform the area into a permeable parking lot that will reduce stormwater runoff.

The \$2.4 million project is being done by Michael Facchiano Contracting, Inc. of Mt. Lebanon.
