**Hard to Recycle Collection Event Coming in July to Bethel Park High School...**

***Advance Registration Required***

*Bethel Park, PA* – Not sure how to get rid of your old phones, computer towers, microwaves, and other special items? Register now for the upcoming “*Hard to Recycle Collection Event*” happening Saturday, July 18 at Bethel Park High School, 309 Church Rd., from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m.

Items that can be recycled at no cost include: cell and home phones; computer towers and peripheral equipment; expanded polystyrene packaging material; glass bottles, jars and jugs; microwave ovens; stereo equipment; and VCRs, DVD players and cable boxes.

A fee will be charged to drop off fluorescent tubes, printers, small Freon appliances, and car and truck tires with or without rims.

A fee of \$20 will be charged to accept computer monitors; \$30 for televisions; and \$40 for projection or console televisions.

The following COVID-19 safety procedures will be in place: placing your items in your car trunk or truck bed; wearing a face mask at all times; staying inside your vehicle; and paying with a credit or debit card if possible for contactless payment.
