Lindermer Street Vacation, Application
No. 2021-1072, Glenn Yocca for Sparrow
Applied Designs request a street vacation of
Lindermer Street, an unopened road from the
Zimmerly No. 28 Plan of Lots.

The unopened road is located between property Lot & Block Nos. 392-F-225, 392-B-175, 392-B-170, 392-F-260, 392-F-261, 392-F-263, 392-F-266, 392-F-269. It's currently zoned -- zoning is C-2 Commercial in Ward 4.

The way the process will work is, we'll have KP, our Municipal Planner, give an overview of what we're looking at tonight. And then we'll open the floor for people -- the Applicant, if they would like to speak.

At that time, then we would open the floor for Public Comments from proponents; people that would be in favor, and opponents; people that would be against.

At this time, can I turn to KP.

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MS. PRIMM: Before Council is a

Street Vacation Application. The Applicant,

Mr. Glenn Yocca, is petitioning for the

vacation of a portion of Lindermer Street, a

40-foot-wide right-of-way.

The area proposed to be vacated is 40 feet wide and approximately 125 feet in length, measured from its point of connection with the previously vacated portion of Lindermer Street, approximately 400 feet in length.

So there are six parcels of property that abut this portion of Lindermer Street. Five parcels are owned by the applicant, Glenn Yocca, and one is owned by 25R624 Realty LLC.

The properties to the south of
Lindermer Street have frontage on Library
Road. And the properties to the north of
Lindermer Street have frontage on
Broughton Road. The unimproved street
right-of-way is subject to the proposed
vacant petition.

As per the requirements of the Bethel Park Municipal Code, Chapter 59,

- 1 Streets, Sidewalks and Public Places, Section 59.77, Petition for Vacating 2 3 Street, the purpose of this Public Hearing 4 is to accept public testimony regarding the 5 application. Council is required to hold a Public Hearing on such petition. 6
- 7 The Application Status: Planning 8 Commission recommended approval at their 9 January 12, 2022 meeting. The Applicant was informed of the Planning and Zoning 11 Commission recommendation for approval with 12 conditions in a letter dated January 19, 2022. 13
