And as we've stated, we're here to propose an Intermunicipal Liquor License Transfer in the Municipality for use at their existing location at 2401 South Park Road, Bethel Park, PA, 15102.

The license is being transferred from its current owner, which is public safekeeping with the Liquor Control Board, the Royal One, Incorporated, which operated a restaurant at 600 Weyman Road, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15236, Whitehall Borough.

And pursuant to Section 461(b)(3) of the Pennsylvania Liquor Code, we're required to have a Public Hearing to obtain a resolution from the receiving Municipality before we can apply to the Liquor Control Board for our transfer.

Crave BBQ is a national franchise concept. They recently opened their facility about three weeks ago. And the co-owner, Brian Schlatterer, has 23 years of experience in the restaurant industry.

The food menu is BBQ, burgers, hot dogs. They have approximately 55 seats inside and nine outside. Hours of operation, Sunday through Thursday, 11:00 a.m. till 9:00; and Friday and Saturday, from 11:00 a.m. till 10:00.

They currently have 15 employees, but are looking for more. They renovated the space. It's a brand-new construction. They spent over \$400,000 renovating the space. And we are happy to be here tonight asking for your support.
