The Lower Chartiers PRP was last revised in 2019 at the start of the current MS4 Permit period. The updated Lower Chartiers PRP proposes the following changes:

First, Additional parsed area from MS4 boundaries; including removal of Allegheny County and PennDOT-owned right-of-ways. The parsed area will decrease Bethel Park's required annual pollutant reductions by approximately 10,000 pounds pollutant per year.

Second, additional nutrients, including nitrogen and phosphorus found in fertilizer, are added as a pollutant of concern. This change is required by the Pennsylvania DEP and PRP.

And third, and finally, the modification of BMPs set forth for the current MS4 Permit period-primarily a change from Marbury Road Pond to Peter Page Park Stream Restoration.
