for proposed Zoning Ordinance Amendment,

Medical Marijuana Facilities.

The proposed ordinance amends the Zoning Ordinance to add provisions and regulations for medical marijuana facilities. The definition section now includes definitions for academic, clinical research center, medical marijuana dispensary, and medical marijuana grower/processor.

It is also -- it also includes a statement that all definitions in the Medical Marijuana Act, Act 16 of 2016, and incorporated by reference, the Ordinance would permit a medical marijuana dispensary under 4,000 square feet in a C-1 Zone, academic clinical research centers in a C-2 Zone, C-3, and C4 Zones, and medical marijuana growers/ processors in the MLI Zoning District.

The Public Hearing, the way this will work is, Mr. Harbison, who's our Municipal Planner, will give a brief overview. We will

- 3 opportunity to speak. Or the opponents;
- 4 people opposed to this proposed zoning
