9 So this is about the Proposed Zoning
10 Ordinance Amendment for Chickens and Ducks,
11 just to make a note.

12 We are considering the enactment of
13 Ordinance 4-13-26A repealing Section 69.35.4.7
14 of the Code of Ordinances of the Municipality
15 of Bethel Park, Specific Standards for
16 Chickens, and replacing it with a new
17 Section 69.35.4.7, Specific Standards for
18 Keeping of Domestic Chickens and Ducks, to
19 regulate the keeping of chickens and ducks in
20 the Municipality.

21 Can I have a role call, please.

24 Take your time.

9 that there's no pub- -- no public was present.

10 PRESIDENT JANOSIK: Yep. I noted for
11 the record that there were no opponents nor
12 proponents --

13 MS. DENNE: Okay.

14 PRESIDENT JANOSIK: -- in the
15 audience.
