

## **NORTHEAST TENNESSEE/VIRGINIA HOME CONSTORTIUM BOARD**

The HOME Consortium is composed of contiguous units of general local government – Bluff City; Bristol, Tennessee; Bristol, Virginia; Johnson City; Kingsport; Sullivan County and Washington County. The HOME Consortium’s main purpose is to establish policies and direct the program delivery for funds granted by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the purpose of improving regional housing opportunities.

The Consortium is governed by a seven-member (7) board with the Mayor or her/his appointed designee from each Cooperating Unit serving as a voting member. The HOME Consortium Board meets on the third Wednesday of January, April, June and September at 10:00 a.m. in the Municipal Annex Conference Room.
