What is required?

1. \$7.50 for each team member
2. Prepare an electric roaster (**not a Crock-pot**) of Chili, Soup or Stew approximately 4.5 Gal.
3. Meat or food thermometer to maintain 135 Degrees
4. A 25 ft. extension cords at least 12 gauge.
5. All serving utensils & latex gloves
6. List of ingredients to post for safety (no recipe unless you want to)

What you may bring?

1. You may bring anything but drinks you would like to sell, or to promote you org.
2. Any condiments you may wish to supply at no charge.

Judging format:

A Panel of Judges will be appointed to judge all chili, Soup or Stew entries

Each voter can get one sample of each chili entered (sample 1-2 Tablespoons ea.)

Cups, spoons and napkins will be supplied by CUMC

Venders

Any equipment needed to display your goods (Approx. 4' x 8' Sch. Table Available, first come, one ea.)

Camden United Methodist Church will supply all Desserts, Soft Drinks and Bottled Water \$1.00 ea.

No outside drinks allowed

Entertainment will be supplied by DJ, with a Karaoke Contest until 6:30 pm; Pre teen Winner will be determined by Vote (\$1.00 ea.) Trophies & Prizes will be awarded as soon as vote can be counted after competition is over.
