

RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING PART OF DISPOSAL FEE
FOR CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS

Whereas, Ohio House Bill 432, which becomes effective April 15, 2005, allows the Hamilton County General Health District to collect disposal fees from construction and demolition debris landfills primarily for the purpose of funding its inspection and enforcement programs; and

Whereas, Ohio House Bill 432 also allows for a portion of those tipping fees to be disbursed to various agencies and local government jurisdictions in which the construction and demolition debris landfill operates; and

Whereas, the Rumpke Sanitary Landfill, which receives construction and demolition debris, operates within Colerain Township.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of Colerain Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

1. The Board of Trustees does hereby appropriate from the disposal fee collected by the Hamilton County General Health District for construction and demolition debris, the maximum portion of the fee permitted by law, specifically four cents per cubic yard or eight cents per ton, for the purposes specified under O.R.C. Section 3734.57(C)
2. The Board of Trustees directs the Clerk to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Hamilton County General Health District, with instructions to pay over to the Township the portion of the said disposal fee appropriated by this resolution.
3. Upon remission of the Township portion of the disposal fee, the Clerk shall deposit said monies in the Township General Fund, and shall maintain separate records therefor.
