This is Battalion Fire Chief Frank Cook of the Colerain Township Department of Fire and Emergency Medical Services (Colerain Fire and EMS) reporting on a building fire that occurred in the 9400 block of Yellowwood Drive in the Northgate neighborhood on Tuesday, November 26, 2013. At approximately 7:20 PM, the Hamilton County Communications Center received an Emergency 911 call for a report of smoke in the basement of a building.

Upon arrival, the first on scene fire company encountered moderate smoke conditions on all interior levels of a residential dwelling. Firefighters found active fire in the basement of the building involving an electric clothes dryer. The lone occupant of the building stated he was alerted to the fire by his barking dog. The incident was declared under control in approximately 10-minutes.

There were no civilian or firefighter injuries reported.

The determination of origin and cause of the fire is under investigation by the Colerain Fire and EMS. Damage was estimated at \$5,000.00.

Thirty-one firefighters from Colerain Fire and EMS and Forest Park Fire Department were utilized at this incident.
