



ALL ITEMS MUST BE AT THE CURB BEFORE 6:00 AM ON YOUR COLLECTION DAY

Each home is allowed the following per week:

- 10 – 35 gallon bags or containers per week
 - Weighing less than 60 pounds each
 - Containers over 35-gallons not permitted
 - Break down cardboard boxes and bundle with string, do not place trash in cardboard boxes
- 2 – Freon-free bulk items
 - Couch, chair, table, stove, mattress, dresser, washer, dryer, etc.
- Refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners contain a gas called freon. By law, the freon must be removed before these items can be disposed of. There is a \$30.00 fee to remove the freon, you may purchase the sticker for this at the Treasurers Office or call DPW for more information at 791-6000. Putting out one of these items does count as ONE bulk item.

If you will have over the limit outlined above, call the DPW at 791-6000 to schedule a special pick-up for a fee a minimum of 24 hours before your trash day.



Household Rubbish & Yard Waste Guidelines



Items That Cannot Be Taken:

- Liquid Waste
- Oil/Antifreeze
- Wet Paint Cans
- Tires
- Propane Tanks
- Hazardous Waste
- Asbestos
- Dry Wall
- Car/Boat Parts
- Concrete
- Construction Debris/Fencing
- Rocks/Bricks/Landscaping Stones
- Sod/Tree Stumps/Rail Road Ties
- Cans/Bags Over 35-Gallons
- Yard Waste Mixed With Rubbish
- Steel/Wood Poles Over 4 Feet Long

Other Rubbish Guidelines:

CARPET

Roll and tie carpet and padding in rolls less than 4-feet in length and weighing less than 60 pounds each. Carpet rolls can be counted as your part of the 10-cans or bags as long as they are properly prepared as stated above. Call for a special pick-up if you will have more than 10-bags/cans and carpet rolls in one given week. Wet carpet will weigh more than 60 pounds. Do not place carpet out in the rain.

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS IS NOT ACCEPTED AT THE CURB. If you are having work performed by a contractor, have them haul your material away or call Waste Management for a rate on a dumpster at 1-800-796-9696.



Yard Waste Is:

- Grass clippings
- Leaves
- Brush under 2 inches in diameter (pencil thin)
- Garden/weed clippings

Yard Waste Does NOT include:

Sod, root balls, pet waste, dirt, large branches, trash, pumpkins, hay

Each home is allowed 10 paper bags, cans or bundles per week:

- 10 – 35 gallon bags or paper yard waste bags or bundles are allowed per week
 - Containers **MUST** be marked with “YARD WASTE” stickers *(available at City Hall and DPW)*
 - Weighing less than 60 pounds each
 - Containers over 35-gallons not permitted
- Brush must be tied and bundled:
 - No more than 4 feet in length
 - Weighing no more than 60 pounds
 - Loose brush or shrubs not accepted

Other Yard Waste Guidelines:

- Do not place yard waste in plastic bags, it cannot be collected.
- Do not mix trash with yard waste, it cannot be collected.
- Make sure you store yard waste out of the rain during the week.
- Wet yard waste is heavy and may exceed the weight limit.
- Place all material out for collection **BEFORE 6:00 AM** on your collection day.
- Do not place garbage out before 6:00p.m. the day before your scheduled collection day.
