- Item 1. Chairman Garrison called the meeting to order at 3:40 pm.
- Item 2. Approve the Minutes from the February 27, 2025 MPO Policy Board Meeting

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve the February 27, 2025 Policy Board meeting minutes. Councilman McMasters made a motion with a second from Councilman Pike. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 3. Adopt Resolution 25 – 22 approving the FY 2026 Draft Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Mr. Hellums explained that the 2026 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) contains the work tasks and budget to be conducted by the MPO staff for Fiscal Year 2025. Mr. Hellums stated the document will have a 30 day comment period.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 25 - 22. Councilman McMasters made a motion with a second from Chairman Long. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 4. Adopt Resolution 25 – 23 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to decrease construction funding for the following project:

Intersection Improvements on Vaughn Bridge Road at SR-3 (US-31)

Mr. Hellums explained that this resolution is for a decrease in construction cost. The Original Estimated Cost was \$1,977,201 with a decreased estimated cost of \$141,582.41 for a new Total Cost of \$1,835,618.59. The MPO will be responsible for 80% of the cost with the City of Hartselle being responsible for the remaining 20%. This project has bid.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 25 - 23. Councilman McMasters made a motion with a second from Councilman Pike. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 5. Adopt Resolution 25 – 24 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to increase right-of-way funding on the following project:

Intersection Improvements including Turn Lanes and Traffic Signal at SR-36 and Lando Cain Road

Mr. Hellums explained that this resolution is for an increase in right-of-way cost. The Original Estimated Cost was \$208,120 with an increased estimated cost of \$41,880.00 for a new Total Cost of \$250,000.00. The MPO will be responsible for 80% of the cost with the City of Hartselle being responsible for the remaining 20%.

Chairman Garrison called for a motion to approve Resolution 25 - 24. Councilman McMasters made a motion with a second from Chairman Long. The motion carried unanimously.

ALDOT representative Rodney Ellis explained this project is in the beginning phase of planning to replace the deck of the two bridges on I-65 south of Thompson RD and the two bridges on I-65 over AL-67. Project is estimated to let late FY 2026.

After coordinating with you via phone calls and emails about the Carbon Reduction Grant that the city will be applying for, we are providing this Fee Proposal for the Preliminary Engineering and Construction Engineering & Inspection for the proposed project.

It is understood that the intent of the project is to improve eight (8) signalized intersections within the city with panoramic video detection systems. Preparing engineering design and construction drawings for these intersections will be required as well as construction engineering and inspection during the project to ensure compliance with specifications, drawings, and standards. 




