- Item 1. Vice Chairman Bodley called the meeting to order at 2:10 pm.
- Item 2. Approve the Minutes from the February 27, 2025 Technical Coordinating Committee Meeting

Vice Chairman Bodley called for a motion to approve the February 27, 2025 Policy Board meeting minutes. Mr. Borden made a motion with a second from Mr. Ellis. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 3. Adopt Resolution 25 – 22 approving the FY 2026 Draft Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Mr. Hellums explained that the 2026 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) contains the work tasks and budget to be conducted by the MPO staff for Fiscal Year 2025. Mr. Hellums stated the document will have a 30 day comment period.

Chairman Bodley called for a motion to recommend Resolution 25 - 22. Mr. Borden made a motion with a second from Mr. Griffith. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 4. Adopt Resolution 25 – 23 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to decrease construction funding for the following project:

Intersection Improvements on Vaughn Bridge Road at SR-3 (US-31)

Mr. Hellums explained that this resolution is for a decrease in construction cost. The Original Estimated Cost was \$1,977,201 with a decreased estimated cost of \$141,582.41 for a new Total Cost of \$1,835,618.59. The MPO will be responsible for 80% of the cost with the City of Hartselle being responsible for the remaining 20%. This project has bid.

Chairman Bodley called for a motion to recommend Resolution 25 - 23. Mr. Griffith made a motion with a second by Mr. Borden. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 5. Adopt Resolution 25 – 24 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to increase right-of-way funding on the following project:

Intersection Improvements including Turn Lanes and Traffic Signal at SR-36 and Lando Cain Road

Mr. Hellums explained that this resolution is for an increase in right-of-way cost. The Original Estimated Cost was \$208,120.00 with an increased estimated cost of \$41,880.00 for a new Total Cost of \$250,000.00. The MPO will be responsible for 80% of the cost with the City of Hartselle being responsible for the remaining 20%.

Chairman Bodley called for a motion to recommend Resolution 25 - 24. Mr. Borden made a motion with a second from Mr. Griffith. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 6. Adopt Resolution 25–25 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following project:

Level of Effort Section 5307 Decatur (Apportionment FY 2023)

Mr. Hellums explained this resolution is for a transit project using Fiscal Year 2023 money.

Chairman Bodley called for a motion to recommend Resolution 25 - 25. Mr. Borden made a motion with a second from Mr. Griffith. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Hellums explained this resolution is for a transit project using Fiscal Year 2024 money.

Chairman Bodley called for a motion to recommend Resolution 25 - 26. Mr. Borden made a motion with a second from Mr. Griffith. The motion passed unanimously.

## Item 8. New Business

Adopt Resolution 25 - 27 to amend the current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following project:

Bridge DECK REHAB (HYDRODEMO) on I-65 Bridges over Cedar Creek (BIN 9536, 9537) and over SR-67 (BIN 9921, 9922)

Mr. Hellums explained he received this project information after sending out the meeting agenda. Chairman Garrison agreed to add the project under new business for this meeting. ALDOT representative Rodney Ellis explained this project is in the beginning phase of planning to replace the deck of the two bridges on I-65 south of Thompson RD and the two bridges on I-65 over AL-67. Project is estimated to let late FY 2026.

Chairman Bodley called for a motion to approve Resolution 25 - 27. Mr. Ellis made a motion with a second from Ms. Arriaga. The motion carried unanimously.

ALDOT Project Updates from Mr. Rodney Ellis:

- Hartselle Vaughn Bridge / US 31 project has bid.
- Hartselle Lando Cain Rd and AL 36 intersection project. Design 85% complete. ROW ongoing.
- Hartselle ATRIP project on 31 and Sparkman St. Design is 85% complete.
- Hartselle TAP grant in downtown is 30% complete.
- Priceville resurfacing has started.
- Priceville TAP grant to install sidewalks along Upper River Rd and Bethel Rd. Design is ongoing.

- Church Street project is in the design phase.
- Decatur 6<sup>th</sup> Ave project has bid and a contractor has been selected.
- Decatur Causeway Lighting Project is ongoing.
- Decatur ATRIP II project at Upper River Rd and AL 67 intersection.
   ROW acquisition is complete and building has been demoed. Project is proceeding to Geotechnical studies.
- Decatur TAP grant to update sidewalks on 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. Permits are approved. Waiting to bid.
- Beltline Road in Decatur resurfacing has bid. Contractor to begin work soon. Work will be done at night.
- Morgan County culvert project. Schedule to bid in July.
- Trinity ATRIP II project at S Greenway DR and AL 24. Project has bid and contractor is in the procurement phase.
- I-65 TISMO project to install message boards and traffic cameras from Priceville to Athens. Project has started.
- I-65 bridge replacement in Lacon over Flint Creek and railroad. Design is 30% complete. Schedule letting FY 2025.
- I-65 resurfacing project has bid. Project will start soon. Project will include over pass bridge repairs and bridge raising.
- I-65 sign replacement project has bid. Contractor is in the procurement phase of the project.
- I-65 Tennessee River Bridge repair and painting project ongoing. Project is estimated to be 80% complete.
- I-565 widening project in Limestone and Madison County is approximately 25% complete.
- Norfolk Southern Railroad Bridge crossing in south Limestone County.
   Design is 90% complete. ROW ongoing. Scheduled letting later FY 2025.
- AL 20 resurfacing project in Decatur is ongoing.
- AL 24 resurfacing project is ongoing.

Mr. Hellums updated the board on the status of the new 2050 Traffic Demand Model and Long Range Transportation Plan.
