City of Everett's GUIDELINES

**TO A CLEAN, SAFE AND
HEALTHY
NEIGHBORHOOD**



**For the health, safety and
welfare of your neighbors,
the City of Everett requires
you to observe the
following regulations:**

Trash Disposal and Storage:

- Store trash in barrels weighing no more than 50 pounds.
- Place trash at your curb after sunset on the evening before collection.
- If your removal day falls on a holiday, it will be collected one day later.
Holidays: July 4th, Christmas Day, Labor Day, Patriots' Day, Memorial Day, Thanksgiving, New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Columbus Day, Presidents' Day.
- Do not include any of the following in your trash: appliances, dirt or stone, construction debris, or hazardous waste (paint, tires or TV/monitors).
- **Please put your trash at the curb and refrain from blocking the sidewalk.**
- Take in empty barrels before 12:00 Midnight on the day of collection. If your trash is not collected, you must take it back to your property.
- Recyclable plastics, glass, cans and papers in the recycling bin provided to you by the city.

Building and Fire:

- **Obtain a permit from the Building Department before making any improvements to your home.**
- Make sure that all sleeping quarters are in compliance with State & Local Codes.
- Overcrowded apartments are in Violation of State Health Codes.
- Test your fire and smoke alarms to make sure that they are in working order.

Care of Animals:

- Vaccinate your dogs and cats against rabies and license your dog each year at the City Clerk's office.
- **Leash your dog when it is not on your property and clean up after your pets.** Do not allow your dog to disturb the neighborhood by barking.
- Keep your dog out of parks, school grounds and cemeteries.

Care of Property:

- Keep grass, bushes and trees trimmed and pools clean. Standing water and overgrown weeds attract pests that are dangerous to humans.
- Remove all vegetation that overhangs public sidewalks.
- Do not allow trash to accumulate on your property.
- Do not keep "junk" cars on your property.
- Keep all property dumpsters permitted, closed and free of overflowing garbage.
- Make sure that your dwelling has the proper street number affixed and visible.
- When shoveling your driveway or walks, do not put snow on the sidewalks or streets. **It is the property owners responsibility to shovel the sidewalk.**
- Store lawn or garden waste in paper bags only for collection during spring and fall.
- Pools must be fenced in and enclosed at all times.
