

“MARCH MADNESS” VACCINATION CLINIC

Mayor Carlo De Maria J. and the Everett Health Department would like to announce an upcoming “March Madness” Vaccination Clinic open to Everett residents.

Vaccines to be offered at the Clinic include H1N1 (Swine) flu, Seasonal flu and Pneumonia. It is still flu season and a third wave of H1N1 flu is still possible. The Clinic will be held on Friday March 26, 2010 at the Everett Health Department, City Hall, Room 20, 484 Broadway in Everett from 2:00pm to 6:00pm. The clinic is free of charge and open to all Everett residents. There is no charge for the vaccines and no appointments are necessary. H1N1 flu vaccine will be available for ages 6 month and above and Seasonal Flu and Pneumonia vaccine for ages 19 and above.

We ask that you enter City Hall from the entrance in the back from the parking lot and please wear short sleeve clothing. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult. For children under 10 needing a second dose of H1N1 vaccine, their first dose had to have been received before February 27, 2010. this will be the last scheduled Flu clinic for the 2009-2010 Flu season.
