2010 RESIDENT PARKING STICKERS AVAILABLE IN JANUARY

Mayor Carlo DeMaria Jr. and Parking Clerk Paul Kelly remind car owners that Residential Parking Stickers will be distributed free of charge during the months of January and February.

When the stickers are officially available, to speed processing at City Hall the Parking Clerk requests residents to bring the following: the expired 2009 sticker (Orange sticker,) your valid Massachusetts Vehicle Registration (must have Everett Address.) Residents with leased vehicles must also bring their valid Massachusetts Drivers License.

During the months of January and February all overnight parking ordinances will still be in effect. Effective March 1st, 2010 all residents will require the official 2010 sticker. For complete information please visit the Parking Clerk's office or the city's website – www.cityofeverett.com.
