CITY GETS \$75,000 GRANT FROM EXXON MOBIL FOR YOUTH SUMMER JOBS

Mayor Carlo DeMaria is very excited to announce the availability of Summer Jobs for local youth. Through a generous \$75,000 grant from Exxon Mobil, the city will again offer The City of Everett's Exxon-Mobil Green Team Program. Positions will be available to Everett Residents ages 17-20. The program will start at the beginning of June and run through mid August.

"I'm very happy that our partnership with Exxon Mobil will continue," states Mayor DeMaria, "last year the kids did a great job, and this year we'll be able to hire more Everett kids." With more time for planning, the Mayor will also create specific programs for the Green Team to work on.
