

Medical Supplies Needed

The Everett Health Department and Mayor Carlo DeMaria, Jr. are supporting the Haitian Earthquake relief effort by collecting the following specific medical supplies. Items will be collected through February 3rd for transport by a delegation of doctors and nurses traveling to Haiti to assist with the medical response. All items can be dropped off at the Everett Health Department, City Hall, Room 20, 484 Broadway. We request that only the following items be donated at this time. Please keep in mind that no liquids or gels will be accepted as all items are being transported via airplane. Please contact the Health Department at 617-394-2256 with any questions.

The requested medical supplies include:

- Latex gloves & non latex gloves
- alcohol wipes
- hand sanitizer
- IVs
- Antibiotics
- Tape for bandages
- Bacitracin
- Bandages
- Vaseline
- Antibiotics for skin wounds/infections
- Sterile water
- Large rolls (4inches wide) gauze
- 4" X 4" sponges
- ABD pads
- Band aids – all sizes
- Ibuprofen
- Tylenol – regular and PM
- Advil
- Motrin
- Blood pressure machines
- Blood sugar testing machines
- Thermometers
- Heart monitors
- Sterile Cotton Tipped Applicators (6 inches)
- Antiseptic Powder (Newspring is the brand name)
- Sterile Cotton balls
- OB Peri Pads (Kotex)
- Disinfectant – (Peppermint Spirit is the brand name)
- Face cloths
- Zip lock bags
- Toiletries (non liquid)
