#### 1.00 SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL

Proposals along with vendor proposal form can be submitted to the Program and Recreation Manager, Farmington Civic Center – 2 Black Knight Drive, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. Each proposal must be clearly marked as a proposal for Apparel - Farmington Parks and Recreation. The deadline for proposals is 2:00 PM, December 17, 2025. No proposal will be accepted after the deadline for submission of proposals, regardless of the reason for such lateness, and will be returned to sender unopened.
