1.00 SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL

Proposals along with vendor proposal form can be submitted to the Program Manager, Farmington Civic Center – 2 Black Knight Drive, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. Each proposal must be clearly marked as a proposal for Youth Sports Photography - Farmington Parks and Recreation.

The deadline for proposals is 2:00 p.m., December 10, 2025. No proposal will be accepted after the deadline for submission of proposals, regardless of the reason for such lateness, and will be returned to sender unopened.

2.00 QUESTIONS AND INTERPRETATIONS
