City Council Minutes of Meeting March 14, 2013 6:30 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on March 14, 2013 at Long Memorial Hall, 110 West Columbia Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Stuart Landrum.

Mayor Landrum gave the invocation.

The roll was called with the following Councilmen present: John Robinson, Larry Forsythe, Lynn Crites, Darrel Holdman, Joe McMillen, Dennis Smith, and Corey Gibson. Mark Kellogg was absent.

City Counselor, Scott Reid, was present.

Councilman Holdman made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Councilman Smith, and passed unanimously.

Chuck Henson, 3364 Springbrook Farms, addressed the Council to deliver information regarding the First Baptist Church "You are the Light" Mission Project 2013.

Reports were given by Committee Chairs and the City Administrator with Council discussion.

Councilman Smith made a motion to participate in Missouri Grant Programs, seconded by Councilman Holdman, and passed unanimously.

Councilman Smith made a motion to decline the grant from the State of Missouri for construction of two storm shelters, seconded by Councilman Robinson, and passed unanimously.

Greg Shinn of Thurman, Shinn, & Company, gave the Audit Report for the Fiscal Year 2012.
