City Council Minutes of Meeting October 10, 2013 6:30 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on October 10, 2013 at Long Memorial Hall, 110 West Columbia Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Landrum.

Mayor Landrum gave the invocation.

Councilman Holdman made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Councilman Kellogg, and passed unanimously.

Reports were given by Committee Chairs and City Administrator with Council discussion.

Councilman Holdman made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, seconded by Councilman Kellogg, and passed unanimously.

Councilman Kellogg made a motion to postpone Bill 67092013 to the October 28 meeting, seconded by Councilman Crites, and passed unanimously.
