City Council Minutes of Meeting January 27, 2014 6:30 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on January 27, 2014 at Long Memorial Hall, 110 West Columbia Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro-Tem Smith.
