Councilman Kellogg made a motion for the first reading by title only of Bill 78102014, seconded by Councilman Smith, and passed unanimously.

Counselor Reid read the following Bill once by title only.

BILL 78102014: AN ORDINANCE GRANTING APPROVAL TO T.M. CROWLEY & ASSOCIATES/CVS PHARMACY, FOR THE PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT/PLAT APPROVAL FOR CVS PHARMACY SUBDIVISION.

Counselor Reid read the following Bill once by title only.
