## **CITY OF FARMINGTON**

City Council Minutes of Meeting July 9, 2015 6:30 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on July 9, 2015, at Long Memorial Hall, 110 West Columbia Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Landrum.

Mayor Landrum gave the invocation.

The roll was called with the following Councilmen present: Mark Kellogg, Garett Boatright, Dennis Smith, John Crouch, John Robinson, Larry Forsythe, Lynn Crites, and Darrel Holdman.

City Counselor, Scott Reid, was present.

Officials present were: Greg Beavers, Dylan Mosier, Michelle Daniel, Floyd Massey, Todd Mecey, Karen Roman, and Paula Cartee.

Councilman Holdman made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Councilman Kellogg, and passed unanimously.

Reports were given by Committee Chairs and City Administrator with Council discussion.

Councilman Forsythe made a motion to purchase a fence for the recycling center to be relocated on Industrial Drive, seconded by Councilman Crites, and passed unanimously.

Councilman Holdman made a motion to approve the consent agenda, seconded by Councilman Kellogg, and passed unanimously.

Councilman Kellogg made a motion for the second reading by title only and Council action on Bill 38062015, seconded by Councilman Smith, and passed unanimously.

Counselor Reid read the following Bill once by title only.

BILL 38062015-ORDINANCE 1-605: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO REQUIRE FINGERPRINTING FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION OF JOB CANDIDATES FOR THE CITY OF FARMINGTON. The roll was called as follows: Councilman Kellogg, aye; Councilman Boatright, aye; and Councilman Smith, aye; Councilman Crouch, aye; Councilman Robinson, aye; Councilman Forsythe, aye; Councilman Crites, aye; and Councilman Holdman, aye. Eight (8) ayes, and no nays, Bill Passed.

Councilman Kellogg made a motion for the first reading by title only and Council action on Bill 39072015, seconded by Councilman Smith, and passed unanimously.

Counselor Reid read the following Bill once by title only.

BILL 39072015: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, MISSOURI, AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, TITLE II: PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE BY ADDING CHAPTER 237: SMOKING REGULATIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SUBMISSION OF THIS ORDINANCE TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY FOR THEIR APPROVAL AT THE MISSOURI GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2015.

Councilman Kellogg made a motion for the first reading by title only and Council action on Bill 40072015, seconded by Councilman Smith, and passed unanimously.

Counselor Reid read the following Bill once by title only.

BILL 40072015: AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO THE EXISTING CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, MISSOURI. (VARGO ROAD AND PERRINE ROAD)

Councilman Kellogg made a motion for the first reading by title only and Council action on Bill 41072015, seconded by Councilman Smith, and passed unanimously.

Counselor Reid read the following Bill once by title only.

BILL 41072015: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GENERAL ZONING ORDINANCE AND ACCOMPANYING MAP THERETO AND KNOWN AS GENERAL ORDINANCE 11-2I BY CHANGING THE CLASSIFICATION OF THE ZONE DISTRICT FOR CERTAIN PARCELS OF LAND DESCRIBED HEREIN. (912 W LIBERTY STREET)

Councilman Forsythe made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilman Crites, and passed unanimously.
