City Council Minutes of Meeting June 22, 2015 6:30 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on June 22, 2015, at Long Memorial Hall, 110 West Columbia Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro-Tem, Dennis Smith.

Councilman John Robinson gave the invocation.

Councilman Holdman made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Councilman Kellogg, and passed unanimously.

BILL 33062015-ORDINANCE 1-603: AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MINERAL AREA COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT; DESIGNATING A PORTION OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, MISSOURI, AS A BLIGHTED AREA PURSUANT TO THE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ACT, SECTIONS 67.1401 TO 67.1571 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF MISSOURI, AS AMENDED; APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF THE INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO THE DISTRICT; AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN OTHER ACTIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.
