City Council Minutes of Meeting November 28, 2016 6:30 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on November 28, 2016, at Long Memorial Hall, 110 West Columbia Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Landrum.

Mayor Landrum gave the invocation.

The roll was called with the following Councilmen present: John Robinson, Larry Forsythe, Dale Wright, Darrel Holdman, Mark Kellogg, Garett Boatright, Dennis Smith and John Crouch.

City Counselor, Scott Reid, was present.

Officials present were: Greg Beavers, Rick Baker, Floyd Massey, Chris Conway, Robert Sullivan, Todd Mecey, Michelle Daniel and Paula Cartee.

Councilman Robinson made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Councilman Wright, and passed unanimously.

Reports were given by Committee Chairs with discussion.

Councilman Smith made a motion to move the December 26 Council Meeting to December 19, seconded by Councilman Boatright, and passed unanimously.

Greg Beavers, City Administrator, provided an update and answered questions from the Council.

Councilman Forsythe made a motion to authorize Greg Beavers to write a letter confirming that the City of Farmington does not intend to assert its use of the Short Street right-of-way or the unnamed alley way that are currently encroached upon by the garage and shed structure located at 603 Columbia Street, seconded by Councilman Crouch, and approved unanimously. 
