## CITY OF FARMINGTON

City Council Minutes of Meeting September 14, 2017 6:30 p.m. Amended

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on September 14, 2017, at Long Memorial Hall, 110 West Columbia Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Forsythe.

Councilor Robinson gave the invocation.
