City Council Minutes of Meeting April 12, 2018 6:30 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on April 12, 2018, at Long Memorial Hall, 110 West Columbia Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Forsythe.

Mr. Don Brown gave the invocation.

The roll was called with the following Councilors present: Darrel Holdman, Mark Kellogg, Vanessa Pegram, Wayne Linnenbringer, John Crouch and Dale Wright.

Councilor Holdman made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Councilor Kellogg, and passed unanimously.

BILL 09032018: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, MISSOURI, AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, TITLE I: GOVERNMENT, CHAPTER 110: MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL, ARTICLE II: MEETINGS RULES AND PROCEDURES. The roll was called as follows: Councilor Holdman, nay; Councilor Kellogg, aye; Councilor Pegram, aye; Councilor Linnenbringer, nay; Councilor Crouch, aye; and Councilor Wright, aye. Four (4) ayes and two (2) nays, Bill Failed. Councilor Robinson and Council Eaves absent and not voting.

Councilor Wright made a motion to approve the Election Results, seconded by Councilor Crouch, and passed unanimously.

BILL 10042018-ORDINANCE 11-664: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, MISSOURI, APPROVING AND ACCEPTING A FINAL RECORD PLAT AT JOHNS BUCKHAVEN PLAT 2 PHASE 2 (CASE FRP-18-001). The roll was called as follows: Councilor Parks, aye; Councilor Robinson, aye; Councilor Holdman, aye; Councilor Joyce, aye; Councilor Pegram, aye; Councilor Linnenbringer, aye; and Councilor Crouch, aye. Seven (7) ayes and no (0) nays, Bill Passed. Councilor Robinson absent and not voting.

Councilor Crouch made a motion for the first reading by title only of Bill 11042018, seconded by Councilor Holdman, and passed unanimously.

Counselor Reid read the following Bill once by title only.

BILL 11042018: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, MISSOURI, BY AMENDING TITLE IV: LAND USE, CHAPTER 405: ZONING REGUALTIONS, ARTICLE VI: SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS, SECTION 405.230, ACCESSORY BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES.

Councilor Crouch made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilor Linnenbringer, and passed unanimously.
