

CITY OF FARMINGTON

City Council Minutes of Meeting March 23, 2020 6:30 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on March 23, 2020, at Long Memorial Hall, 110 West Columbia Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Forsythe.

Councilor Pegram made a motion to allow Councilors to attend by video conference or telephone due to an emergency, COVID-19 and social distancing orders and recommendations to prevent the spread of the virus, seconded by Councilor Joyce, and passed unanimously.

Councilor Tom Joyce gave the invocation.

The roll was called with the following Councilors present: John Robinson (Via ITV), Dennis Robinson, Tom Joyce, Vanessa Pegram and Wayne Linnenbringer.

City Counselor, Scott Reid, was present.

Officials present were: Greg Beavers

Councilor Pegram made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Councilor Dennis Robinson, and passed unanimously.

Kevin Berry, 22 Tanglewood, addressed the Council regarding the Coronavirus. (See Attached)

Reports were given by Committee Chairs with discussion.

Tammy Alsop, Hochschild, Bloom & Company, LLP, provided the Council with an Audit Report.

Greg Beavers, City Administrator, provided an update and answered questions from the Council.

Councilor Linnenbringer made a motion to approve the consent agenda, seconded by Councilor Pegram, and passed unanimously.

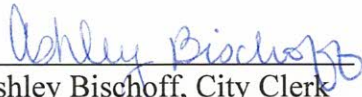
Councilor Joyce made a motion for the first and second reading by title only of Bill 16032020, seconded by Councilor Pegram, and passed unanimously.
