# PLANNING AND ZONING MINUTES OF MEETING

### **OLD BUSINESS**

1. Discussion of Rules Related to Bed & Breakfasts (Table A)

Tim Porter, Development Services Director, presented the case to the Commission. The Commission discussed the issue.

A motion was made by (G. Boatright) and seconded by (C. Morrison) to hold off on approving options until the Commission has time to review the options presented.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

An Application for Annexation at 1716 North Washington Street with a Requested Zoning of "R-4: General Residential". (Case ANN-21-002) Submitted by Aaron McDowell on behalf of JanJer, LLC.

Tim Porter, Development Services Director, presented the case to the Commission. The Commission discussed the issue.

Aaron McDowell, representative for JanJer, addressed the Commission to explain that they have excluded a small 150 foot by 800 foot tract of the property because it would not allow for sewer without a lift station, which would substantially increase the cost, and MODOT has verbally approved an entrance with a possible right hand turning lane.

Mayor Forsythe asked what the comprehensive plans says about islands (that are not annexed). Tim Porter, Development Services Director, responded that it does not plan for islands.

A motion was made by (G. Boatright) and seconded by (C. 2. Donation of Cemetery Property. (1250 Stonegate)
