- Cost Sharing for Extending Kiesha Lane, south of Johns Buckhaven Subdivision The Committee discussed the issue. H. Peterson motioned reimburse Steve Johns \$6270.00 for the 58 foot road extension from Buckhaven Subdivision, seconded by V. Pegram. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion
- 3. Other Items of Interest Jim Coleman, 202 Arrowhead, explained that he has stormwater issues, he has worked on the water issues on his property over the last several years but his dam is continuing to get washed out. V. Pegram recommended tabling the discussion and moving it to the Administrative Services Committee.
