ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS TO AGENDA

- Proposed Stop Sign on Stonegate at John David V. Pegram motioned to approve and send to Public Safety for their concurrence. The motion was seconded by H. Peterson. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.
