MINUTES OF MEETING

The Public Works Committee of the City of Farmington met in regular session on April 8, 2021 at the Public Works Building, 12 South Franklin Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640.

At 5:00pm, C. Morrison called the meeting to order.

The roll was called with the following members present: David Kennedy – absent; Chris Morrison – present; Vanessa Pegram – present; Harry Peterson – present.

Guests present were: Larry Lacy, Larry Forsythe, and Kristen White.

ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS TO AGENDA

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

V. Pegram motioned to approve the March 11, 2021 meeting minutes, seconded by C. Morrison. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Fleming Sidewalk Update – L.Lacy provided an update on the project. The Committee discussed the issue but no action was taken.
2. Basketball Goals in the Street – The Committee discussed the issue and agreed to end the discussion.
3. 1400 W Liberty Street - Quality Inn – The Committee discussed the issue but no action was taken.
4. Electric Shop/Warehouse Sprinkler Contract Update – L. Lacy provided an update on the cost of the project. The Committee discussed the issue. V. Pegram motioned to approve the extra \$18,000.00 for the project, for a total of \$149,930.00. The motion was seconded by H. Peterson. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

NEW BUSINESS

1. “Slow Deaf Child” Sign Request on North and South Carleton (601 Healy) – The Committee discussed the issue. V. Pegram motioned to deny the request and share the literature L. Lacy found with Public Safety for discussion. The motion was seconded by H. Peterson. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.
2. Creek Erosion at 510 N Carleton, 1310 Dawn, 843 & 851 Timberline Drive, and 301 Edward Street – The Committee discussed the issue but no action was taken.
3. Pipe Extension Request at 1176 Spring Brook Park Drive – The Committee Discussed the issue but no action was taken.
4. Stop Sign Request on Hawthorn at Dawn – The Committee discussed the issue. H. Peterson motioned to deny the request, seconded by V. Pegram. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.


5. Stop Sign Request on Maple at Woodlawn – The Committee discussed the issue. V. Pegram motioned to put a stop sign on Maple at Woodlawn with a 90 day trial and send to Public Safety with a favorable recommendation. The motion was seconded by C. Morrison. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.
6. Spring Clean Up on Private Streets –The Committee discussed the issue and agreed that the cleanup should be allowed at Butterfield Gardens, Cherry Creek Condos, and Vandiver. L.Lacy stated that he would give direction to the Street Department. No further action was taken.
7. Solar Power Ordinance Change – L. Lacy had not yet received information for this item. The Committee did not discuss the issue.
8. Other Items of Interest - None
