NEW BUSINESS


1. Doubet Road Ditch - Deleted

3. Accepting Maintenance and Repair of Infrastructure for Mountain View Phase 3 (Shepard Mountain Road, Stono Mountain Drive, Buford Mountain Road, Bell Mountain Drive) - The Committee discussed the issue. C. Morrison motioned to start the clock (1 Year) for the time to begin on accepting maintenance and repair of infrastructure for Mountain View Phase 3, seconded by V. Pegram.
