MINUTES OF MEETING

The Public Works Committee of the City of Farmington met in regular session on October 13, 2022 at the Development Services Building, 12 South Franklin Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640.

At 5:02pm, W. Linnenbringer called the meeting to order.

The roll was called with the following members present: Adam Parks – present; Garrett Boatright – absent, Chad Follis – present; Wayne Linnebringer – present.

ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS TO AGENDA

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

A. Parks motioned to approve the September 8, 2022 meeting minutes, seconded by C. Follis. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Weber Road / Grand Canyon Extension – Mayor Forsythe stated that City will buy the property located at the end of Grand Canyon Drive in order to extend the road and add a fire substation.

The Committee discussed the issue, but no action was taken.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Discussion of November Meeting Date – L. Lacy stated that he cannot be at the normal November meeting date and asked the Committee about rescheduling.

C. Follis made a motion to cancel the November meeting and hold the next meeting on December 8, 2022, seconded by A. Parks. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

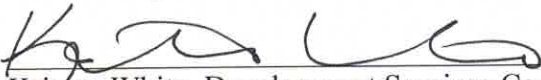
2. Discussion of Pedestrian Crosswalk on Liberty Street, Between First Freewill Baptist Church and the Farmington Public Library, Submitted by Joye Meinsen. – L. Lacy stated he will address the issue. The Committee discussed the issue, but no action was taken.
3. Airport Lighting Project – Greg Beavers, City Administrator, stated that in a few weeks the City is putting out bids for replacement of the airport lighting systems. The Committee discussed the issue but no action was taken.

4. Hangar and Airport Ground Lease – Greg Beavers, City Administrator, presented an exhibit showing the empty lot at the airport and stated that Kyle Short wants to build a hanger there, Skywatch Aviation wants to use space in the airport for their fight school, and he will work on a lease. The Committee discussed the issue, but no action was taken.
