PUBLIC WORKS
MINUTES OF MEETING

The Public Works Committee of the City of Farmington met in regular session on December 8, 2022 at the Development Services Building, 12 South Franklin Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640.

At 5:05pm, W. Linnenbringer called the meeting to order.

The roll was called with the following members present: Adam Parks – absent; Garrett Boatright – present, Chad Follis – present; Wayne Linnenbringer – present.

Guests present were: Larry Lacy, Greg Beavers, Mayor Forsythe, Tim Porter and Kristen White.

ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS TO AGENDA

G. Boatright motioned to delete New Business item two, seconded by C. Follis. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

G. Boatright motioned to approve the October 13, 2022 meeting minutes, seconded by C. Follis. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Weber Road & Plaza Street Intersection Design

The Committee discussed the issue. G. Boatright motioned to approve exhibit one from CBB (Crawford, Bunte, Brammeier Traffic and Transportation Engineers), restrict Weber Road to right in, right out, and remove the stop sign on Weber Road at Plaza Drive, seconded by W. Linnenbringer. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

2. Infrastructure Cost to Provide Power to New Developments

L. Lacy presented data on what City costs have been to provide main line power to the Koppeis subdivision, which totals \$406,000.00.

C. Follis asked if amortization has been looked at. L. Lacy responded that he would review with City Administrator, Greg Beaves, and have more information available at the next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Request for Sidewalk Continuation, Submitted by Kenneth Kluver

The Committee discussed the issue. G. Boatright motioned to approve the sidewalk continuation on the west side of Westmoor and put the project at the end of the priority list, seconded by C. Follis. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

2. Discussion of Airport Ground Lease and Construction of Airplane Hanger

3. Discussion of Decorative Lights on the Jefferson Street Plaza

The Committee did not discuss the issue due to time constraints.

4. Discussion of Vacating Right-of-Way in Butterfield Gardens.

The Committee discussed the issue. G. Boatright motioned to table the issue due to time constraints, seconded by C. Follis. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

5. Stop Signs at Both Ends of Doe Run Lane

L. Lacy stated that the street name has been changed to Deerfield Lane. G. Boatright motioned to approve the stop signs on both ends of Deerfield Lane, seconded by C. Follis. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

6. Drainage Issue Solution at Franklin and Columbia (200 W Columbia)


L. Lacy stated that the street crowns and creates problems with water backing up almost into the buildings in this location and recommended that the City work on lowering the crown.

Brad McDowell, 200 West Columbia, asked where else this has been done in the City. L. Lacy responded that it was done at Hickory Street and Morris Street.

G. Boatright motioned to recommend a crown cut across Columbia Street, seconded by C. Follis. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

ADJOURN

C. Follis motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by G. Boatright. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of the motion.
