## PUBLIC WORKS MINUTES OF MEETING

The Public Works Committee of the City of Farmington met in regular session on January 12, 2023 at the Development Services Building, 12 South Franklin Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640.

At 5:01pm, W. Linnenbringer called the meeting to order.

The roll was called with the following members present: Adam Parks – present; Garett Boatright – present, Chad Follis – absent (arrived later); Wayne Linnenbringer – present.

Guests present were: Larry Lacy, Mayor Forsythe, Tim Porter and Kristen White.

#### ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS TO AGENDA

L. Lacy stated that the Mayor requested the Discussion of Decorative Lights on the Jefferson Street Plaza be deleted. G. Boatright motioned to delete Old Business item two, seconded by A. Parks. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

#### MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

G. Boatright motioned to approve the December 8, 2022 meeting minutes, seconded by A. Parks. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

#### OLD BUSINESS

- 1. Weber Road & Plaza Street Intersection Design Further Discussion
  - L. Lacy stated that he did not need a definite answer for three or four months, the Jersey barrier is no longer an option, and MODOT prefers fiber glass poles instead. The Committee discussed the issue. G. Boatright motioned to table the issue until the Mayor gives his input, seconded by A. Parks. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.
- 2. Discussion of Decorative Lights on the Jefferson Street Plaza

- 3. Discussion of Vacating Right-of-Way in Butterfield Gardens.
  - L. Lacy stated that the odds of using the right-of-way are very slim. The Committee discussed the issue. G. Boatright motioned to send a favorable recommendation to the Planning and Zoning Commission to approve the request, seconded by A. Parks. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

1. Stop Sign Request at Janey Drive and Log Cabin Lane

The Committee discussed the issue. G. Boatright motioned to send a favorable recommendation to the Public Safety Committee if the proposed Private Sports Complex at 545 Wallace Road is approved, and a neutral recommendation if it is not approved, seconded by C. Follis. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

### 2. FEMA Flood Map Revisions

- L. Lacy presented maps with revisions from FEMA. The Committee discussed the issue, but no action was taken.
- 3. Closing Bray Rd. (across from Sanjewell)
  - L. Lacy stated that this piece of Bray Road has been used as a party spot recently, and Greg Beavers, City Administrator, proposed adding a barrier across the road with a locking cable and posted phone number to open if needed. The Committee discussed the issue. G. Boatright motioned to approve adding a barrier, seconded by C. Follis. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

#### **ADJOURN**

G. Boatright motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by C. Follis. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of the motion.
