Mayor Landrum stated that a Public Hearing is being held to gain input regarding:

1. An application for Planned Unit Development (PUD)/Site Plan Approval (Case PZPUD-12-001). The owner of the property requests the City of Farmington grant a Planned Unit Development/Site Plan Approval for property recently annexed into the City's Corporate Limits. The property (5.98 Acres, Plat of Annexation Description, A tract of land located in the County of St. François and the State of Missouri, lying in part of Fractional Section 23, Township 36 North, Range 5 East of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a found iron rod marking the West Quarter Corner of said Section 23; thence north 62°16'28" East 1,865.52' to a found iron pipe located on the East right-of-way of United States Highway "67" and the Northwest corner of Deed Book 1575 at Page 1585 of the Land Records of St. François County, Missouri, the POINT OF BEGINNING of the tract herein described; thence along said right-of way of United States Highway 67 North 20°59'13" West 495.25' to a set No. 4 rebar marking the Southwest corner of Deed Book 909 at Page 731 of the Land Records of St. Francois County, Missouri, thence leaving said Right-of-way of United States Highway 67 along the South line of said Deed Book 909 at Page 731 North 89°24'05" East 534.22' to a found drill steel marking the Southeast corner of said Deed Book 909 at Page 731 and on the West right-of-way of Flat River Road; thence along said West right-of-way of Flat River Road 180.03' along an arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 2,837.00' through a central angle of 03°38'09" and whose cord bears South 26°04'55" East 180.00' to a set No. 4 rebar; thence continuing along said West right-of-way of Flat River Road South 21°52'38" East 342.27' to a found iron pipe marking the Northeast corner of said Deed Book 1575 at Page 1585; thence along the North line of said Deed Book 1575 at Page 1585 North 88°50'59" West 563.60' to the point of beginning. Containing 5.98 acres, more or less. Being all of Deed Book 1496 at Page 909 and Document 2012R-01065 of the Land Records of St. Francois County, Missouri.) is located at 4670 Flat River Road/2100 Block of Weber Road. The Planned Unit Development/Site Plan Approval includes the naming of the Private Roadway Access as "White Oak Drive" and the corresponding address assignment for each Residence and Site within the development. The property is currently zoned "R-5" Manufactured and Recreational

Residential Zoning District. Submitted by Town and Country - 67 Development Co., LLC.

Tim Barnes explained the request. He explained the road will be a private access road maintained by the owner, and it will be accessible for emergency vehicles. He noted that Planning & Zoning gave a favorable recommendation. With no questions or comments, hearing closed at 6:40 p.m.
