Public Hearing Minutes February 24, 2014 6:30 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on February 24, 2014, in the Council Chambers. The hearing was called to order by Mayor Landrum.

An application request for Final Subdivision Plat approval for Mineral Area Regional Medical Center Subdivision (Case PZFRP-13-006) and an annexation request (Case PZANN-13-005) for part of the property).
